History

Established in 2008, UK Internal Audit's (UKIA) internship program has bolstered the classroom knowledge and professional experience for dozens of students from both the Gatton College of Business and Economics and the College of Communication and Information. The program has encompassed the following:

- Paid summer interns from communications, accounting and information technology (IT) fields of study.
- Student teams from a 500-level internal audit class, with participants interested in not only auditing but also IT and communications.
- Spring semester 2020, UKIA enrolled 17 students in the program at a time when others were canceling their internship programs.
- Employers who hire former UKIA interns credit their skills, in part, to their experience working at UKIA.
