The Academic Edition of the ETAP Enterprise Solution provides educational institutions with access to the latest technology for the design, modeling, simulation, and operation of electrical power systems. It provides students the opportunity to learn and apply essential power system concepts utilizing a sophisticated electrical engineering software package. Operation Technology, Inc., has donated a 25 concurrent user network LAN version of the ETAP simulation software with a commercial value of \$814,546 (\$552,728 for software and \$261,818 for the upgrade and user support).
