APPROVAL OF THE 2016-17 ENDOWMENT MATCH PROGRAM ANNUAL REPORT

Background: The Research Challenge Trust Fund (RCTF) was established in 1997 with the passage of House Bill 1, the *Kentucky Postsecondary Education Improvement Act*. The RCTF is designed to encourage research activities at the University of Kentucky and the University of Louisville. The Endowment Match Program, also known as ‘Bucks for Brains’, is one of several programs created as part of the Trust Fund. Pursuant to the Council on Postsecondary Education’s Endowment Match Program Request and Reporting Procedures, the Board of Trustees must review and approve the Annual Report on UK’s participation in the program. Kentucky's flagship and land grant research university has boldly confronted challenges, risen to meet new opportunities, and redefined what it means to be the University *for* Kentucky for more than 150 years. The UK family provides a transformational academic experience that prepares students to lead lives of meaning and purpose; conducts cutting-edge research that addresses the Commonwealth's relevant questions; and renders sophisticated care and service that changes lives and transforms communities.

Today, faced with a new array of complex questions and issues, we find the University again climbing and pushing forward to pioneer new solutions.

During the last 16 years, the “Bucks for Brains” partnership between UK’s Research Challenge Trust Fund and the Commonwealth of Kentucky has been a key component in supporting the innovations made by our faculty, staff, and students. Since its inception, Kentucky has pledged more than \$230 million in state funds to UK, which we matched – dollar for dollar – with private funds to support the research enterprise of our institution. We’ve used these funds:

- As part of the effort to build the University’s endowment from \$420.8 million in Fiscal Year 2001 to more than \$1.4 billion in Fiscal Year 2017.
- To create more than 300 endowed chairs and professorships across all colleges and professional schools; more than 260 fellowships, scholarships, and endowments for research support; and for the William T. Young Library.
- As a key element of increasing our external grants and contracts from \$173.6 million in Fiscal Year 2001 to more than \$331.3 million in Fiscal Year 2017.

With your help, we have catapulted our institution to new heights. The University of Kentucky is continuing its ascent as a top research university and is now ranked 41st among all public research institutions according to the National Science Foundation. This growth is made more remarkable by the fact that we do our work in what is an increasingly competitive environment. Moreover, although research funding at the federal level has been flat, UK has experienced three consecutive years of growth. The Research Challenge Trust Fund and your partnership have been critical to this success.

Indeed, the power of partnerships is not only about today. It is not only about bricks and mortar. It is about the faculty, staff, and students who are working to create a better future. Our goal is to leverage our work today toward a more promising tomorrow, as the University *for* Kentucky. This model – your partnership – will help us continue our ascent and, as a result, improve the lives of citizens across the state and nation.

FOCUS ON FACULTY



Jurgen Rohr

University Professorship in Pharmacy

Jurgen Rohr is a professor of pharmaceutical sciences and director of the division of medicinal, bioorganic and computational chemistry at the University of Kentucky College of Pharmacy. His research centers on natural products and drug discovery, with the strongest focus on elucidating complex biosynthetic pathways, in bacteria, fungi or plants, with emphasis on enzyme mechanisms. The results of these biosynthetic studies are used to generate modified natural product drugs through genetic engineering. Rohr's lab generates and tests new antitumor drugs and drugs against bone diseases, investigates biochemical mechanisms of anticancer drugs, and investigates new

antibacterial agents. Before joining UK in July 2002, Rohr was assistant and associate professor of chemistry and biochemistry at the University of Göttingen, Germany and associate professor of pharmaceutical sciences at the Medical University of South Carolina. He earned an M.S. and Ph.D. from the University of Göttingen and completed a postdoc at The Ohio State University. Rohr is the principal investigator on grants from the National Cancer Institute, National Institute of General Medical Sciences and Department of Defense (Army), which provide annual support of \$500,000 to his research.



Daret St. Clair

James Graham Brown Foundation Endowed Chair

Daret St. Clair, professor and interim chair of the department of toxicology and cancer biology in the UK College of Medicine, co-leads the new Center for Cancer and Metabolism, funded by an \$11.2 million NIH Center of Biomedical Research Excellence (COBRE) grant. Kentucky has disproportionately high incidences of both cancer and metabolic disorders. Kentucky leads the nation in cancer deaths and it has the 10th highest obesity rate in the country. The new center capitalizes on highly specialized institutional strengths in cancer and advanced metabolomics tools to focus on the underlying mechanisms that link dysfunctional metabolism to cancer. Recent studies have

shown that the metabolic powerhouse of cells, the mitochondria, can influence how aggressive a cancer becomes. St. Clair is one of UK's internationally renowned experts in the field of cancer and mitochondria. St. Clair, who joined UK in 1991, is studying the antioxidant enzyme manganese superoxide dismutase (MnSOD), which protects healthy tissue, but suppresses the growth of cancer. Thus, MnSOD may eventually help eradicate cancer while preserving the quality of life of cancer survivors. Her previous research has shown that this enzyme, located in mitochondria, exerts dual functions during cancer development and progression. MnSOD is believed to offer protection against free radicals, molecules with unpaired electrons that move through the body and produce additional reactive oxygen species. She is the associate director of basic research for the Markey Cancer Center, and received an honorary Ph.D. in Science from Mahidol University, in her native Thailand.



Heather Bush

Kate Spade & Co. Foundation Endowed Professor

Heather Bush is an associate professor in the biostatistics department in the University of Kentucky College of Public Health. In June 2015, she became the Kate Spade & Company Foundation Endowed Professor in the Center for Research on Violence Against Women. Prior to joining UK in 2006, Bush worked as a senior biostatistician in industry and was responsible for the design and analysis of health registries. Building on these experiences, she has helped to transform the statistical support provided to investigators at

UK through her leadership roles with the Biostatistics, Epidemiology and Research Design unit within the Center for Clinical and Translational Science and the Applied Statistics Lab, which she co-founded. Her work focuses on outcomes research, but with an emphasis on injury and violence, especially as it applies to women's health and student populations. She is the author of an introductory textbook, *Biostatistics: An Applied Introduction for the Public Health Practitioner*. Bush has won the Provost's Award for Outstanding Teaching, the College of Public Health's Golden Apple Award, and Dean's Outstanding Teaching Performance Award. Bush earned her M.S. and Ph.D. in statistics from UK. She currently serves as co-PI on Women's Health & You, a health registry focusing on factors that impact women's health outcomes, ConnectED: A Randomized Control Trial Connecting through Educational Training, and McBEE: Multi-Campus Bystander Efficacy Evaluation. Both the ConnectED and McBEE studies, funded by the CDC, seek to enhance evidence-based decision-making to identify the optimal campus violence prevention model.

David Van Sanford



S. Lawrence and Elizabeth Ritchey Yost Lea Professorship in Plant and Soil Science

David Van Sanford is a professor of plant and soil sciences at the University of Kentucky College of Agriculture, Food and Environment (CAFE). His research is funded by the Kentucky Small Grain Growers Association, the U.S. Wheat and Barley Scab Initiative and the USDA. Van Sanford's research focus is breeding and development of soft red winter wheat varieties for Kentucky and the mid-south. His team is working to breed varieties resistant to Fusarium head blight, a devastating disease of wheat worldwide. Van Sanford's team also

studies the genetic basis of nitrogen utilization in order to breed high-yielding varieties that require less nitrogen fertilizer. The wheat breeding team has evaluated impacts of climate change through warming studies that identify genotypes with resilience to warming. His team has recently collaborated with a local baker and grower to produce high-protein bread wheat in Central Kentucky in a sustainable manner. Van Sanford has published numerous refereed journal articles, and has developed a number of wheat, barley and oat varieties. He has served as chair of the National Wheat Improvement Committee and the U.S. Wheat and Barley Scab Initiative. He was elected fellow of the American Society of Agronomy and the Crop Science Society of America in 2011 and received the 2014 TP Cooper Award for distinguished achievement in research from CAFE. Van Sanford earned a Ph.D. in genetics from North Carolina State University and joined the UK faculty in 1981.

FOCUS ON STUDENTS

The Endowment Match Program is not only a mechanism to recruit faculty, it also provides research opportunities and financial support for some of the most talented graduate students in the U.S. In Fiscal Year 2017, the Endowment Match Program provided graduate fellowships to 463 recipients.

FOCUS ON KENTUCKY

Bucks for Brains is a primary catalyst for the substantial growth in external research funding to the campus and to Kentucky. Since the Kentucky General Assembly passed the Postsecondary Education Improvement Act of 1997 (House Bill 1), external research grants and contracts at the University have increased from \$122 million to \$331.3 million (a 172 percent increase). (www.research.uky.edu).

These dollars have an impact on UK's campus. During Fiscal Year 2017, external research grants and contracts resulted in a \$636.2 million contribution to the Kentucky economy, including \$205.1 million in personal income. Each dollar of out-of-state external funding for research generates approximately \$1.92 of total related expenditures.

ENDOWMENT ACTIVITY

Since its creation, the University of Kentucky has received \$233,334,000 in state funds through the Research Challenge Trust Fund for the Endowment Match Program and the Research Capital Match Program which was created by the 2008 Kentucky General Assembly to support research capital projects. Pursuant to its statutory authority, the University of Kentucky Board of Trustees allocated \$21,926,570 to the Research Capital Match Program and the remaining funds have been dedicated to the Endowment Match Program. Per the Program Guidelines for both the Endowment Match Program and the Research Capital Match Program, all state funds have been fully matched by the University on a dollar-for-dollar basis.

Since 1998, the University of Kentucky has used the Endowment Match Program to:

- create 94 endowed chairs and 216 endowed professorships; and
- create 262 fellowships, enrichments and mission support projects to support research and the William T. Young Library (Table 1).

ENDOWMENT MATCH PROGRAM AT A GLANCE

Endowment Match Program faculty have made substantial contributions to the University of Kentucky research portfolio. According to the 2016 report from AUTM, the Association of University Technology Managers, UK tied for 16th in start-up companies among public universities and ranks 32nd among public universities in total licensing income. As of June 30, 2017, UK held 601 worldwide patent assets. In FY 17, UK received \$4,547,906 in gross patent income, 40 patents were issued, and 19 full patent applications and 20 provisional patent applications were filed. In addition, UK held a total of 117 license and option agreements, and issued 13 new licenses and options, including eight to start-up companies.

DEMOGRAPHIC INFORMATION

As of June 30, 2017, the University of Kentucky has appointed a total of 212 faculty endowed chairs and professorships under the auspices of the Endowment Match Program. Of those appointments, 163 (76.9 percent) are male, and 49 (23.1 percent) are female. Of the 685 research staff associated with the Bucks for Brains program, 315 (46.0 percent) are male and 370 (54.0 percent) are female (Table 2).

During Fiscal Year 2017 there were 126 endowments supporting graduate fellowships. Since a single endowment may support multiple student awards, 463 graduate students received support from endowment proceeds (Table 4). There were 179 (38.7 percent) minority students among fellowship recipients.

AREAS OF CONCENTRATION

The Council on Postsecondary Education's 2002-04 and 2008-10 Endowment Match Program Guidelines stipulate that at least 70 percent of program funds at the research institutions must be used to support Research Challenge programs or academic disciplines contained within Kentucky's five new economy clusters: (1) human health and development; (2) biosciences; (3) materials science and advanced manufacturing; (4) information technologies and communications; and (5) environmental and energy technologies. As shown below, the University of Kentucky directed 79.2 percent of the funds to support positions, programs, or projects within the new economy clusters (Table 5).

Pursuant to the 2002-04 and 2008-10 Endowment Match Program Guidelines, the University also directed at least 70 percent of program funds to support chairs, professorships or research scholars, and infrastructure or fellowships directly linked to the research activities of endowed chairs and professors.

FINANCIAL SUMMARY

The University has received all currently available state matching funds for the Endowment Match Program. The market value as of June, 30, 2017, of all endowments created or expanded as part of the Endowment Match Program total \$526,707,453.
