Non-exempt overtime compensation overview

Non-exempt Overtime Compensation (NOC) Criteria and Risks

Fair Labor Standards Act (FLSA) A federal law that establishes standards for:

- Overtime pay
 - Non-exempt employees must be paid 1.5 times their regular rate for hours worked beyond 40 in a work week.
- Minimum wage
- Recordkeeping of hours worked and wages
- Child labor

Kentucky Revised Statutes (KRS) Employers must provide their employees with:

- A "reasonable period for lunch" taken no sooner than three hours after the employee's shift begins but no later than five hours after (KRS 337.355)
- A rest period of at least 10 minutes during each four hours worked (KRS 337.365)



Noncompliance with federal and/or state law may result in:

- Backpay to employees
- Monetary fines
- Employee lawsuits



NOC Activity

UKIA's current fiscal year NOC activity has been **reactive**, consisting of **inquiries** that stemmed from **anonymous reporting**.

UKIA's **planned activity** will use four of its services (shown at right) to provide **reasonable assurance** that NOC practices:

- Incorporate proper internal controls.
- **Comply with applicable regulations**, including the FLSA.
- Adhere to state statutes regarding employee breaks and lunch periods.

Service	Activity
Repetitive audits	UKIA is engaging a series of repetitive audits across the enterprise, beginning with highest-risk areas .
Data analytics	UKIA is developing a data analysis to detect anomalies.
Consultations	UKIA is engaging ad hoc meetings to discuss communicated audit results and trends.
Training	In partnership with Human Resources, UKIA will assist with training related to NOC regulatory compliance and the associated risks . Additionally, UKIA will host a Lessons Learned webinar on NOC compliance.
