



Course Modality Definitions

| SAP Delivery Description | Definition |
|---|--|
| Traditional | Held in-person on the main University of Kentucky campus. |
| Off-Campus Course | Held in-person at a designated off-campus location. |
| Distance Learning - Internet, web-based | Held fully online and do not require any in-person attendance. |
| Distance Learning - Hybrid | Hybrid meetings are primarily held online but require some inperson attendance, such as for midterm or final exams. |
| Distance Learning - Compressed video | Compressed video meetings are broadcast live from an in-person meeting to designated remote locations. Communication occurs real-time between sites. |

 - Health and safety








FLIPPED | ROTATING






Course Modality Summary

 - Welcome to UK programming






Freshman – Five Year Enrollment Timeseries






Freshman – Ethnicity

Retention by Cohort Term






Retained 1st Spring Retained 2nd Fall






2nd Fall Retention by Ethnicity
