


UK Graduate Medical Education (GME) Programs Year End 2024-25


10-year Physician Residency and Fellowship Program Growth





45% of Residents and Fellows Going Into Practice Stayed in Kentucky





Incoming Intern Medical School Training Locations





Growing the Annual Number of Residents and Fellows


