



Federal Parent PLUS Loan



New Regulation

- Loan limits include a cap of \$20,000 per year.
- Aggregate limit of \$65,000 per dependent student.

Student | University Impact

 Limited access to parent loans will drive borrowers to a private alternative loan, but not all will be eligible.

Action Items

- Meet with private alternative loan representatives.
- Outreach to students explaining their options.



Federal Graduate PLUS Loan

New Regulation

Eliminates the Graduate PLUS Loan program.

Student | University Impact

- Students may need to explore other funding options.
- Limited access to federal loans could affect both graduate and professional studies.

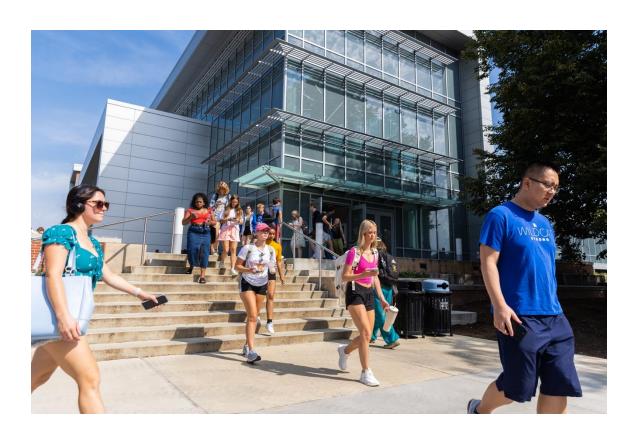
Action Items

- Meet with private alternative loan representatives.
- Outreach to students explaining their options.
- Review graduate scholarship awarding methodology.





Federal Pell Grants



New Regulation

 \$10B in funding added to the 2025-26 award year.

Student | University Impact

 Pell Grants support our neediest students.

Action Items

 Continue to award the maximum Pell Grants at \$7,395.



Institutional Accountability

New Regulation

- Compares median earnings of undergraduate completers vs. "working adults" with a high school diploma or Graduate Equivalency Degree (GED).
- Compares median earnings of graduate completers vs. "working adults" with a bachelor's degree.

Student | University Impact

• If the program fails to meet the earnings threshold, that program is no longer eligible to participate in the federal student loan program.

Action Items

- Working with Institutional Research, Analytics and Decision Support (IRADS) to review the data on income by program.
- Research and review the final details of the new regulation once it is made available to colleges.
