In response to student feedback, a "block" plan also will be available. The block plan includes 130 meals which can be used any time during the semester. Weekly and block plan meals are provided at Commons Market and Blazer Café ("unlimited choices" buffets) and at K-Lair and Ovid's Café (combo meals). Each dining plan also includes 300 "Flex Dollars". Flex dollars can be used at any of Dining Services' 22 locations to purchase a la carte items. Up to 100 Flex Dollars may be carried over from the fall to spring semester.
