#### **State of the Core**

- Broad faculty involvement is critical to the continued success
- Currently in the third year of program implementation
- 236 total courses approved with 167 being taught in Fall 2013
- Course proposals (except for UKC) are processed in eCATS
- Need more Arts & Creativity, Social Sciences, and NPMS courses

## **UK Core Education Committee (UKCEC)**

- Chaired by Dr. Ben Withers
- Standing committee of the Senate
- 10 voting faculty members
- Functions include:
  - Approval of courses
  - Long-term oversight (including periodic review)
  - o Propose recommendations to enhance the program
  - Set policies for transfer/waiver credit

## **Assessment Update**

- C&C and Citizenship evaluation took place in May 2013;
  Inquiry and Quantitative Reasoning will be May 2014
- All courses must upload an assignment for assessment purposes (every semester)
- Each outcome will be assessed every two years in May by faculty evaluators utilizing the area evaluation rubric
