RE: Program Change – BSN

Attached please find a request to amend the pre-requisites for the Undergraduate BSN program for traditional students. The addition of BIO 103 as a pre-requisite does not change the number of hours required as it has already been identified as fulfilling the Intellectual Inquiry Area of the UK Core for the Natural, Physical and Mathematical Sciences. The impetus to add this as a pre-requisite was the change to UK Core and the courses available to fulfill the natural/physical/mathematical science area. The content offered in this course will strengthen the foundation for students as they enter into pathophysiology and microbiology and so making it a pre-requisite for admission to the professional level was a natural progression, given the progression of the courses. The course will also meet the pre-requisite for NFS 212 which is required of professional level students.

This request is for the four year option of the BSN degree. The second degree option has already been addressed in a prior request.
