

To Whom It May Concern:

The Gifted Education Program has been a joint venture between the Departments of Curriculum and Instruction and Educational Psychology and Counseling. Both departments provided an instructor to teach courses in the certification program. Curriculum and Instruction lost its instructor in the Gifted Education Program about four years ago. With an Educational Psychology and Counseling retirement in December 2005, we lost the last faculty member focusing on this area. Given a relatively low demand from teachers seeking this endorsement coupled with no instructors in the program, we made the logical decision to suspend the program.

We chose to suspend the program in lieu of canceling the program. There is a strong possibility that the Department(s) may reactivate the program at some point in the future. If demand were to increase and the Department(s) has (have) needed financial resources, we would certainly be interested in rebuilding this program.

It should be noted that College of Education programs are facing upcoming state and national accreditation reviews. With no faculty members and only a handful of teachers completing certification in this area, it is imperative that the program be suspended. There is no way that we could get the program accredited given our ability to staff the program.

Meeting called to order at 1:35 p.m. Members present were Tricia Ferrigno (EDL), Kim Miller (KHP), Joan Mazur (EDC), Jane Jensen (EPE), Lee Ann Jung (EDSRC), Keisha Love (EDP) and Associate Deans Rosetta Sandidge and Eric Anderman (ex-officio). Administrative Associate Jason Horger took notes.

New Business:

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- Suspension of a Program: Gifted Education

Dr. Ferrigno expressed an interest in establishing a reworked program centered in the department of Educational Leadership & Supervision. (The current program is co-sponsored by two departments: Curriculum & Instruction and Educational Counseling & Psychology.) She pointed out that across the state there is a demand for teachers and administrators certified in this area. Dr. Mazur, representing Curriculum & Instruction, conceded this point, but stressed that as she is listed as the current contact person for the program, she has had to cope with the lack of program faculty available to implement advising, the continuous assessment apparatus, and the inability to offer courses in the program's areas. Dean Sandidge clarified that suspending the program did not preclude a future proposal for a reconfigured Gifted Ed program.

The proposal PASSED with one abstention (EDL).

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Meeting was adjourned at 2:40 pm.
