

GRII-5 and GRII-6

The Executive Committee is required to submit to the Board of Trustees at each meeting, for the latter's consideration and approval, a complete record of the proceedings of the Executive Committee. The authority of the Board of Trustees to amend the action of the Executive Committee does not extend to the rejection of any valid or authenticated expenditure of money by the Executive Committee (KRS 1646.190).

The Executive Committee shall serve as a hearing panel in the event of a faculty member, staff employee, or student appeal coming to the Board of Trustees. Any person aggrieved by a final decision of the President may apply to the Executive Committee of the Board of Trustees for a review of the decision. The application for review shall be submitted in writing to the President within a period of twenty days following the decision of the President. The application shall state the decision complained of and the relief sought. An agreement to review the decision is within the sound discretion of the Executive Committee. If the Executive Committee agrees to review the decision, a hearing before the Executive Committee is not a matter of right, but is within the sound discretion of the Executive Committee. The Executive Committee shall also serve as a hearing committee in the event of a community member or group desiring to address the Board of Trustees. (ARII-1.0-4)
