The following proposal has been reviewed by the University Senate Admissions and Academic Standards Committee:

### **Third Bachelor's Degree**

Currently, no language exists in the University Senate Rules that addresses whether or not a student can earn more than two bachelor's degrees at the University of Kentucky. (Requirements for a second bachelor's degree are explained in Senate Rule 5.4.1.3.) During the 2007/2008 academic year, the Senate Admissions and Academic Standards Committee requested, and received, a "Sense of the Senate" discussion on the subject of obtaining more than two bachelor's degrees. During the Sense of the Senate discussion, there was no opposition to the concept of a student obtaining more than two bachelor's degrees. As a result, the SA&ASC approves the idea of allowing a student to obtain more than one bachelor's degree.
