RE: Name Change

I want to begin by thanking the Senate Council and the Faculty Senate for their support during the transition of the Orthopaedic Division within the Department of Surgery to our own Department. With our new status as a Department, my plan for the future is to focus on those services that best support the mission of the University as well as generate a return on any investments in the Department.

It is my understanding that the new Department's name was established as the "Department of Orthopedics". In a recent faculty meeting, we discussed our concerns. The faculty feels that the traditional spelling, which originated in 1741 and is used by both the American Board of Orthopaedic Surgeons (ABOS) and the American Association of Orthopaedic Surgeons (AAOS), should be used. The AAOS has requested that all practices use "ae" for consistency. The AAOS not only provides physicians educational and management services but also provide Patient/Public information in forms of websites, brochures and other educational materials that use the spelling Orthopaedic. Also, after researching the 20 benchmark institutions that were used in the review for our Department status 18 of the 20 spell Orthopaedic with and "ae".

Another reason for changing it to the Department of Orthopaedic Surgery relates to the signage already established within the Kentucky Clinic. The signs are spelled with the "ae". The cost of changing the overhead signage and elevator signage in the clinic will run the Department approximately \$2,000.

I have attached for your review a signature sheet of the faculty supporting the change and a copy of the benchmark Institutions. I want to thank you in advance for your consideration in changing our Department's name to the "Department of Orthopaedic Surgery".


