- 3.** Recommendations on Policies. The SACPT is also charged with making a continuing study of regulations on faculty appointment, reappointment, promotion, tenure, privilege and academic freedom, making recommendations to the University Senate.

The Senate's Advisory Committee on Appointment, Promotion and Tenure (SACAPT) is made up of the chairs of the academic area advisory committees. *This committee provides advice to the Senate/Senate Council on matters of policy relating to faculty appointment, promotion and tenure.*

Proposed charge:

The SC charges the members of the SACPT and SACAPT with meeting with Provost Tim Tracy and reviewing UK's current title series system to determine the feasibility of changing to a system with two title series (tenure-eligible and non-tenure-eligible), with ranks in both series at assistant professor, associate professor, and (full) professor, with the inclusion of multi-year contracts (rolling or not) for faculty in the non-tenure-eligible title series.
