Dear Senate Council,

The Department of Modern and Classical Languages, Literatures and Cultures has requested that the name of their department, major, and minor be amended in SAP. Currently their department is listed as Modern and Classical Languages and the major/minor is listed as Modern and Classical Lang, Lit, and Cult.

The College of Arts and Sciences requested that the Departments of German Studies, French, Russian and Eastern Studies, and Classics be merged into a single department of Modern and Classical Languages, Literatures and Cultures in 2002. This change was approved by The University Senate on April 22, 2002.

The creation of the B.A. and B.S. in Modern and Classical Languages, Literatures and Cultures was approved by the University Senate on November 10, 2014.

SAP has a forty-character limit that keeps the department from using the accurate name of their department, major, and minor.

As a result, we request that the name of the department be amended in SAP to reflect the University Senate approved name with the abbreviation Modern & Classical Lang, Lit & Culture\$.
