The student switched the degree to the Bachelor of Science in Geological Sciences after the degree list had been approved by the Senate.

The student was awarded the Bachelor of Science in Geology in December 2017.

Due to this administrative error, the College of Arts & Sciences requests that the Bachelor of Science in Geology degree awarded in December 2017 be rescinded, and the Bachelor of Science in Geological Sciences degree (Dec 2017) be awarded instead.
