<i>Rationale for proposal:</i>	At its retreat in May 2022, the Senate Council expressed concern that the Senate's committee structure did not have obvious bodies to review issues related to faculty employment, nominees for committees, and the academic calendar. Draft charges and a composition were reviewed and approved for three such new standing committees at the Senate Council's regular meeting on August 22. This cover page is accompanying the formal change to the Senate Rules, to add a charge and composition for three new standing committees.
